Christchurch Tragedy : Dealing with Friday's terrorist attack in Christchurch is difficult for all of us. Feeling upset by such events is in the nature of being human. However, our school is a safe place for all of us and we are here to comfort and support all students and their families. This morning schools received a document that provides advice about ways we may be able to assist students if they require support.
