Baime Cave Excursion On Friday of Week 6, Mr Stewart will be taking our school's Junior AECG members and ATSI students to Baime Cave in Milbrodale. Once there, our students will participate in a range of activities, led by Wonnarua elder Uncle Warren and community leader Michael Heitmeyer. Baime Cave is of state significance for its association with the main figure depicted in the art work in the cave, believed to be Baime, who is understood by some Aboriginal people across NSW to be the creator and the most important ancestor and law-maker. The site is also of state significance for its history and association with the Wonnarua, the Aboriginal people who are understood to be the traditional custodians of the artwork. The painting is representative of the traditional heritage of the Aboriginal people of the Hunter Valley and NSW. The establishment of our Junior AECG in recent years has provided incredible interest for students and has been invaluable in embedding Aboriginal perspectives in our curriculum.


