Attendance Regular attendance at school is essential for students to learn and consolidate key academic concepts and also to develop and maintain friendships with others. Our school monitors school attendance data to ensure that students are regularly engaging with school. In the event of low levels of attendance, our school will contact families to discuss options that may assist to increase attendance rates. The Department of Education has clear policy expectations regarding student attendance and the school's role in monitoring attendance. An explanation for any student non-attendance must be provided to the school within 7 days of the first day of absence. Our attendance rolls are checked daily and are also reviewed regularly by Home School Liaison officers (HSLO). Please contact me if you would like further information about strategies to support your child's attendance.

Kinder Parents Assembly Next Monday we will be inviting the families of our Kindergarten students to attend our K-2 assembly. The assembly will feature a guest speaker, Beck Raward, who will discuss a social skills program she will be implementing at our school. The program, 'Learn To Play', is aimed at developing skills in spontaneous play for students. Students will also develop confidence in unstructured activities and in a range of settings. Students will undertake 8 learning workshops over the course of Term 3. Bec, who is a qualified 'Art in Health' facilitator, will address our parents and carers at the assembly and discuss her program in detail. Parents will then be able to speak with Bec if they would like their child to be involved in the program.

Covid Intensive Learning Support Program (ILSP) I would like to introduce two new staff members who have recently commenced at our school. Mrs Lee Moore (Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays) and Miss Jessica Hayes (Thursdays and Fridays) will provide learning support in aspects of Literacy for small groups of students from K-6. Mrs Moore and Miss Hayes have hit the ground running and I'm sure they will deliver great outcomes

for our students. The program will continue until the end of





the year.

Rugby Trials Congratulations to our talented Rugby players, Max and Cooper, who have been selected in the Regional Rugby Union squad of 30.
