Recipe: Fried rice salad

Serves: 4 Ingredients:

- 2 tsp vegetable oil
- · 1 onion, diced
- 1 red capsicum, diced
- 1 green capsicum, diced
- 1 carrot, diced
- 50g ham
- · 4 cups cooked brown rice
- 125g canned corn kernels, drained
- · 6 shallots, finely sliced
- 1/4 cup reduced salt soy sauce
- · 8 cherry tomatoes, halved



Method:

- Heat oil in large fry pan over high heat.
- Saute onion, capsicum, carrot and ham for 3-4 minutes.
- Add rice, corn, shallots and soy sauce. Sitr fry for 2-3 minutes, mixing well.
- Transfer to a bowl to cool.
- Spoon into air-tight containers and top with cherry tomatoes.
- Store in the fridge until ready to be placed in the lunchbox.
- 7. Pack in your lunchbox with an ice brick to keep food cool and safe.
